



LET ACCESS SERIES 2019 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Who can join the LET Access Series?

All female amateurs with a handicap of two (2) or better and all female professionals who are a member of a recognised Professional Golf Association or Tour

2. Do I lose my amateur status if I become a member of the LET Access Series?

The LET Access Series abides by the rules regarding Amateur Status as outlined by the R&A. When becoming a member, you will state within the membership form that you are an amateur. When you enter an event, you will need to sign an 'Amateur Waiver Form', which protects your Amateur status. If an amateur joins the LETAS and then turns professional at any stage during the 2019 season, the Order of Merit points earned in either status will count towards the official LETAS Ranking.

3. I am under 18 years of age can I become a member of the LET Access Series?

Special permission must be sought from the LET Access Series and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. If the application is accepted, you must be accompanied at every event by a parent or guardian.

4. How do I join the LET Access Series?

The online membership form will be available on the LET Access Series website from the 14th January 2019. Once the online membership form is submitted and processed, you will be contacted directly by the LET Access Series with further information.

If you are already a member of the LET, you are automatically a member of the LET Access Series.

5. How do I enter a LET Access Series event?

You will receive log in details to access the LETAS member's area on the website where you will be able to enter the events. The entry fee for each event is €80.

6. How much does it cost to become a Member of the LET Access Series?

If you are a member of the Ladies European Tour, there is no membership or joining fee.

To become a member of the LET Access Series the following fees apply:

Joining Fee: €100

Annual Membership Fee: €200

7. When is the deadline to join the LET Access Series?

Membership can be taken out throughout the season. Ranking points for the Order of Merit will only be awarded for the events in which you are a LETAS member. To be eligible for the LET exemptions available and to appear on the LETAS Order of Merit, a member will be required to play in a certain number of events during the 2019 season. The required number of events will be determined once the 2019 schedule is released.

8. If I become a member of the LETAS does it guarantee that I will play in every tournament that I enter?

No, that will depend on the number of spots in the field and who else has entered the tournament.

Spots in a tournament field will be allocated in exemption category order and position within that exemption category. Players who join LETAS and have competed at the 2019 Lalla Aicha Tour School will receive an exemption category according to their finishing position. Any member who has entered the tournament but does not get into the field will be placed on the reserve list, also in exemption category position and order. Reserves will be notified as soon as possible after the close of entry if they will be in the field due to any withdrawals.
